

Information for Parents/Carers

The Solomontown Primary School Governing Council
approved this policy for all students at Solomontown Primary School

The Governing Council considers the following articles of clothing to be an expectation of school uniform at SPS:

- ◆ Royal blue Solomontown Primary School shirt and hoodie/jumper with logo
- ◆ Black shorts or black long pants
- ◆ Blue and white chequered school dress
- ◆ Blue hat in Term 1 and 4 (supplied by school on enrolment)
- ◆ Safe, sensible shoes suitable for physical activity

Students are expected to wear uniform to school each school day.

- ◆ Parents may purchase royal blue polo shirts from local outlets and an iron-on logo from the school.
- ◆ A limited supply of second-hand shirts are available for sale from the school.
- ◆ A school uniform price list will be included in the school newsletter at the beginning of each school year and updated as prices change across the year when new stock arrives.
- ◆ Students will be supplied with a school hat. If the hat is lost or damaged, parents will be invoiced for the cost of a replacement hat. A new school hat will be provided at the beginning of Year 4.
- ◆ If students are not in uniform, parents will be contacted via a note in the child's diary regarding uniform expectations.
- ◆ If students continue to wear non uniform items of clothing, parents will be contacted and asked to bring uniform clothing to school.
- ◆ If parents cannot be contacted and do not respond within 30 minutes of the initial call, students will be asked to put on a spare piece of uniform clothing for the day; to be returned by the end of the day.
- ◆ If non compliance with the School Uniform Policy continues, parents will be invited to meet with the Principal to resolve issues regarding uniform.
