White Ribbon Day is held on November 19<sup>th</sup>. This year's theme for White Ribbon is 'How can men make change?' White Ribbon Day is known as the International Day for the Eradication of Violence against Women, and is an annual day to raise awareness of family violence.

White Ribbon Day has been running for 17 years, and was founded by a group of men in Canada who felt that they had to raise awareness and work towards prevention of violence against women. The White Ribbon Campaign and Day spread through Canada, with hundreds of thousands of people joining the event in the first year, and wearing white ribbons to oppose violence against women. The wearing of the white ribbon stands for never taking part in, condoning or staying silent about violence against women. Our goal is to create a society where women can live safely from violence and abuse, where equality, safety and respect is the norm and violence against women is never tolerated.

To celebrate White Ribbon Day, Solomontown Primary School are having a whole school community breakfast commencing at 8.30 on November 19<sup>th</sup> (Friday Week 6). 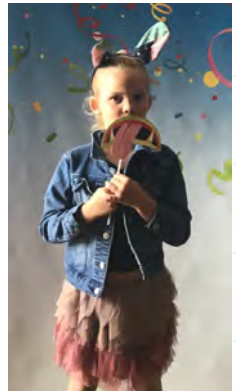
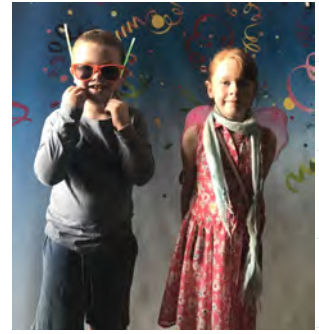
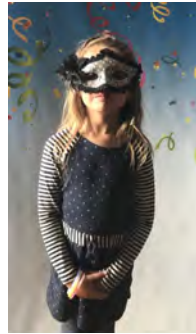
