

### **Acknowledgement of Country**

All classes across the school have been participating in learning about Country and what this means to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander People. This learning has been used to develop an Acknowledgement of Country specific to Solomontown Primary School. An Acknowledgment to Country is our opportunity to show respect for the land and its traditional owners. This will be embedded throughout our school over time.

"We at Solomontown Primary School would like to Acknowledge the Nukunu People as the traditional cusdodians of this land on which we meet upon today. We respect the connections held by Aboriginal People to the land, sea and community of Thalpiri.

In the spirit of reconciliation we pay our respect to elders, past, present and future, we extend that repect to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander People here today.

We would like to thank the Nukunu people for letting us live, learn, play and dream on this land."
